The FDIC's Division of Depositor and Consumer Protection (DCP) offers a series of events for bankers, including teleconferences and webinars, to maintain open lines of communication and update bank management and staff on important bank regulatory and emerging issues in the compliance and consumer protection area.

The next event is a teleconference scheduled for May 21, 2015, that will cover the implementation of mortgage rules issued by the Consumer Financial Protection Bureau. FDIC staff will share observations that FDIC examiners have noted during initial examinations in the first year since the rules became effective. In addition, FDIC staff will highlight a number of practices currently used by some institutions to ensure compliance with the mortgage rules.
