Value

- Part of the management team
 - Management includes both the board of directors and senior officers
 - Quality of management is the most important element in a successful operation
- Ensures the bank's continuing health, viability and vigor

Role

Board of Directors:

- Formulate sound policies and objectives
- Supervise the bank's affairs
- Promote the bank's welfare
- Assess and monitor risk
- Enhance shareholder's value
- Ensure management accountability
- Senior Management:
 - Implement board's policies and objectives in day-to-day operations

- Board Shareholders
- Depositors
- The Community

Qualifications

Integrity

- Must have without exception
- Skills and Experience
 - Contributes to the board's composite judgment
- Ideas and Opinions
 - Courage to express thoughts and beliefs
- Time and Focus
 - Availability to devote to responsibilities

Other Essentials

- Genuine interest in duties
- Recognize and avoid conflicts of interest or appearance thereof
- Independent approach to decision making

Duties - Loyalty

- Prohibits advancement of the director's personal and business interests or those of others at the expense of the bank
- Administer the affairs of the bank with candor, personal honesty and integrity
- Willful ignorance is not a defense against liability for negligence

Duties - Care

- Act as a prudent and diligent business person in conducting affairs of the bank
- Awareness of the bank's condition
 - attend meetings
 - request and review materials
 - ask questions & seek explanations
 - understand audits and supervisory comments
 - exercise independent judgment

Seven Vital Responsibilities

- 1. Regulate the manner in which business is conducted
- 2. Mandate corporate strategies
- 3. Supervise senior officers
- 4. Comply with applicable laws and understand liability
- 5. Avoid self-serving advancement of personal interests
- 6. Establish internal control systems and adequate auditing program
- 7. Ensure sound management information systems
